Dick Bradley was a high school teacher, a co-founder of A Rally of Writers in 1987, and an outdoor writer who published hundreds of columns and articles in newspapers and magazines. His special interests were in poetry and essay. In his memory, we have established the Richard Bradley Scholarship for young writers to attend A Rally of Writers.

A Rally of Writers is a one-day conference for anyone interested in writing. It includes a morning keynoter and 16 breakout sessions, presented by published Michigan authors on the art, craft, and marketing of writing in several genres.

The scholarship will fund registration and lunch (up to \$100) for one winner to attend the Rally conference on April 14, 2018.

Requirements: If you are 15-22 years old, submit an essay of no more than 200 words that explains your interest in poetry or essay and tells why attending Rally is important to you. Be sure your entry reaches us by March 1, 2018. Please include your name, age, address, phone, and email.
